

# ITE San Diego Section Application for Student Scholarship

For 2025, ITE San Diego Section will be awarding the following three (3) scholarships to successful applicants that are pursuing a career in transportation engineering.

- One \$1,000.00 award granted to a graduate student.
- One \$1,000.00 award granted to an undergraduate student or local community college student
- One \$1,000.00 award granted to a high school senior graduating in 2026 planning to pursue a transportation-related program at a college or university.

# The minimum criteria for selection are as follows:

- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Community college, undergraduate and graduate students must be enrolled in a transportation-related program at time of application submission
- Graduating high school seniors must be planning to enroll in a transportation-related program at a college or university for the Fall 2025 semester
- Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field
- Not a previous recipient of the ITE San Diego Section scholarship under the same category

The scholarship is competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation goals, academic record, and transportation-related activities or job skills. If you are selected, your email address may be shared with corporate sponsors for future job opportunities. Additionally, ITE San Diego may contact you to use your name and photo for advertising.

Complete application including biography and personal statement
Proof of Enrollment: Attach a copy of your tuition receipt or current registration card. For high school seniors, please submit a confirmation letter of acceptance into the college or university.
Transcript: Attach a copy of your transcript to application. An online transcript is sufficient.
Letters of Recommendation (optional): Provide any letters of recommendation that support why you would be a good candidate for the scholarship. This is optional, and will be taken into consideration if provided to further understand past roles and responsibilities that align with the scholarship goals.
