8th Grade Finals Week

May 12th-16th Regular Bell Schedule

Thursday, May 15th

- Caps and Gowns will be distributed in the library from 7:30 am – 12:00 pm. A runner will go to your history classroom and ask all graduating students go to the library. You will get in line according to your LAST name and receive your cap/gown. Jostens will be on site to accept any outstanding payments. **If you have not purchased your cap and gown yet, you will be able to purchase on this day.** Payment can be made by cash, card or check.

Friday, May 16th

- Yearbooks passed out.
- 8th grade textbooks need to be returned. Textbooks can be returned sooner.
- Graduation notification – If you are AT RISK for graduation, FINAL GRADES will determine your eligibility for the graduation ceremony. ONLY AT RISK students will receive a notification letter.
 - You are responsible for bringing the letter home and sharing with your parents/guardians. Please do not ask the school before this date if you will be able to participate in the graduation ceremony, as there is no way to answer this with certainty.
 - Graduation Ceremony Requirements
 - Students need a minimum of 48 academic points and/or 2.0 GPA for 7th and 8th grade
 - Students cannot receive 2 suspensions or 1 five-day suspension in the fourth quarter of 8th grade
 - Students cannot receive 3 suspensions throughout 8th grade year
 - Students cannot receive 2 or more F grades in the last grading period

Monday, May 19th (Regular Day)

- 8th Grade Boomers trip. You must wear the 8th Grade Class t-shirt on the trip.

Tuesday, May 20th (Min Day)

- Bell schedule for all students (seventh grade finals day):
 - Period 1 8:00 – 9:10
 - Period 2 9:15 – 10:25
 - Period 3 10:30 – 11:40
- No graduation practice.
- 8th graders will only be going to 1st thru 3rd periods.
- School is dismissed at 11:40.

Wednesday, May 21st (Min Day)

- Check in with your fifth period teacher for attendance and announcements.
- All graduating eighth graders will report to graduation practice on the grass west of the blacktop.
- You will sit with your graduation walking partner at practice.
 - Have your walking partner chosen before graduation practice. Please make sure your partner is eligible to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- Any non-graduates will report to the cafeteria for classroom placement.
- We suggest wearing sunscreen, hat, and sunglasses. Bring bottled water and a snack. It is a long day!
- 8:15 – 11:40 Graduation practice at OJHS.
- School is dismissed at 11:40.

Thursday, May 22nd (Min Day)

LAST DAY OF SCHOOL!

- Check in with your first period teacher for attendance and announcements.
- All graduating eighth graders will report to the bus circle, board any bus and travel to OHS for practice.
- We suggest wearing sunscreen, hat, and sunglasses. You will be in the sun all day. Bring water and a snack.
- 8:15 – 10:15 Graduation practice at OHS. If your parent wants to pick you up from practice, they must see an Administrator at OHS to sign you out from “school”.
- 10:45 return to OJHS. Students may leave upon arrival back to OJHS. (Graduating 8th graders can be checked out at this time, 8th graders remaining on campus will return to 7th period class).

Graduation Ceremony

- Gates open at 5:30 pm. Ceremony starts at 7:00 pm.
- No tickets are needed to attend graduation.
- Arrive at OHS by **6:30 pm IN YOUR CAP AND GOWN**. Meet on the grassy area behind the home side bleachers of the football stadium.
- Do **NOT** bring purses, jackets, balloons, stuffed animals, flowers, cameras, etc. We will **NOT** hold anything for you.
- Please follow dress code standards.
- Diplomas available for pick-up the night of graduation in the OHS gym.
