Beginning the 1st day of the school, the following actions will be taken for noncompliance

- 1. Student will report to the front office
- 2. Student will be offered the opportunity to change into appropriate attire provided by EMS WHEN AVAILABLE or student will call home for parent/guardian assistance. Student will report to L.I.S.T.E.N. and return to their scheduled class upon meeting compliance.
