PBIS stands for Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support and is a framework for setting clear expectations for students, providing support when needed, and recognizing students for positive behavior. For our students to learn these expectations, our students go through a series of rigorous steps to understand expectations for all settings. This culminates with an all school assembly that summarizes the steps on how all students can perform at their best everyday! In the end, the PBIS framework strengthens positive behavior and rewards their great choices!
