WHAT IS GOOGLE CLASSROOM?

Google Classroom is a web-based learning environment. When logged into Google Classroom, students can collaborate with their peers and teachers. Google Classroom offers a digital safe space for students to view class announcements, access posted course content, view posted assignments, and turn in completed work. Only authorized Burlison ISD users (students, teachers, and other designated staff members) can have access to a Burlison ISD Google Classroom.

Please note that any activity in Google Classroom is documented under the student's login.

The Google Classroom is a virtual extension of your student's brick and mortar classroom; parents should use their personal email or other communication tools as offered by the Burlison ISD educators to communicate with the teacher or school.

PARENT/GUARDIAN SUMMARY EMAILS

As a guardian, you must receive and accept an email invitation before you can receive email summaries. Only teachers and administrators from your student's school can send these invitations. You have 120 days to accept an invitation before it expires.

1. The teacher or administrator emails you an invitation for a particular student.
2. The teacher or administrator can send the invitation to any email address.
3. In your email program, open your email invitation.
4. Click **Accept**.
 - If you're not the guardian, click I'm Not The Guardian.
 - You can choose the frequency of the emails, such as daily or weekly.
 - You can unsubscribe or remove yourself from Classroom at any time.

Guardian email summaries include:

- **Missing work**—Work that's late at the time the email was sent
- **Upcoming work**—Work that's due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or work that's due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails)
- **Class activity**—Announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers

You won't receive an email summary if:

- There's no activity to report for the given time period.
- All your student's teachers turned off notifications for their classes.
- You selected **No summaries** for how often you'd like to receive emails.
- You aren't connected to any students in Classroom.
- You did not accept the invitation to receive Parent/Guardian summaries.

¿Qué es GOOGLE CLASSROOM?

Google Classroom es un ambiente de aprendizaje basado en el internet. Cuando los estudiantes usan el programa de Google Classroom, ellos pueden colaborar con sus compañeros de clase y sus maestros. Google Classroom les ofrece un lugar digital seguro a los estudiantes para ver los anuncios, encontrar la materia del curso, ver asignaturas y tareas, y entregar las tareas completadas. Solo los usuarios autorizados de Burleson ISD (estudiantes, maestros, y otro personales designados del distrito) pueden tener acceso a una Google Classroom de Burleson ISD.

Por favor, tenga en cuenta que todas las actividades, mensajes, y acciones que están hechos en Google Classroom son documentados bajo de la cuenta del/la estudiante.

El programa de Google Classroom es una extensión virtual al salón de clase de su hijo/a. Los padres/tutores deben usar su dirección de correo electrónico personal u otras maneras de comunicación proveídas por los maestros del distrito de Burleson ISD para comunicar con los maestros o la escuela.

Los correos electrónicos con resúmenes de progreso para los padres/tutores (el programa de "Guardián View" o "Vista del Guardián/Tutor")

Para ser "Guardián" o tutor del estudiante, tiene que recibir y aceptar una invitación por correo electrónico. Después, puede recibir los correos electrónicos con resúmenes de progreso. Solo los maestros y administradores pueden enviar estas invitaciones. Usted tendrá 120 días para aceptar la invitación que le envían los maestros y administradores. Después de 120 días, la invitación expirará.

Instrucciones:

- 1) Un maestro o administrador le enviará a usted una invitación por correo electrónico con respecto a un estudiante específico.
- 2) Un maestro o administrador puede enviar la invitación a cualquier dirección de correo electrónico según su preferencia.
- 3) Entra su cuenta de correo electrónico y abra la invitación.
- 4) Presione **"Accept"** (aceptar)
 - Si usted no es el tutor legal, haga clic en "I'm Not The Guardian" (No soy el tutor legal)
 - Usted puede elegir la frecuencia de los mensajes de correo electrónico, por ejemplo diario o semanal.
 - Usted puede cancelar la suscripción o eliminarse de una "Classroom" (aula) en cualquier momento.

Los resúmenes incluyen:

- **Las asignaciones que falta el/la estudiante**– Las asignaturas que falta en el momento que se envió el correo electrónico
- **Las próximas asignaciones**– Las asignaturas y tareas que se deben el día de hoy y mañana (cuando prefiere recibir mensajes diarios), o asignaturas y tareas que se deben la próxima semana (cuando prefiere recibir mensajes semanales)
- **Las noticias de la clase**– Los anuncios; las asignaciones, los trabajos, y las tareas; y preguntas recientes de los maestros

No recibirá un resumen por correo electrónico si:

- No hay nada información para informar durante ese día/semana
- Todos de los maestros de sus hijos/as han desactivado las notificaciones para sus clases
- Usted ha elegido **"No summaries"** (**no resúmenes**) como la frecuencia para recibir mensajes
- Usted no está conectado/a a ningunos estudiantes en la "Classroom" (aula)
- Usted no ha aceptado la invitación por correo electrónico para recibir los resúmenes para los padres/tutores
