


Annandale Independent School District is located in the city of Annandale and has an approximate enrollment of 2,000 students from the communities of Annandale, Silver Creek, South Haven, and the surrounding townships.

ACADEMICS

The district has strong systems in place and high standards to support all students and ensure they make progress in their reading, math, and behavior skills. Our high school provides students with additional access to help from teachers during their hour-long lunch. The middle school has established academic support programs before, during, and after school to maximize individual achievement.

The high school utilizes Learning Spaces that provide more personalized learning and increased student ownership of learning. It also offers a variety of concurrent courses through St. Cloud State University and Southwest State University which allows students to explore their interests and earn college credits from the comfort of their high school.

- The district has implemented Q Comp professional learning communities (PLCs) and literacy-focused staff development.
- Catalyst Classroom Management practices are being utilized within the elementary and middle school.
