Please ensure that your child arrives at school by 8:30am with their fully charged district device. Otherwise, they will need to be powered off and placed in their backpacks or locker during the assessment. If a student is found to have a device in their possession while testing, we are obligated to contact the Department of Education, and an investigation will be conducted that may result in disciplinary action.

Make-up testing will be available throughout the full testing window for all subjects in the event that a student is unable to be present for a testing day. Additionally, we will provide wired headphones for all of our Gladiators during testing.

As parents and guardians we also ask that you support your students by ensuring a good night's rest, a healthy breakfast, and words of encouragement before testing as these actions have been shown to help with concentration success!
