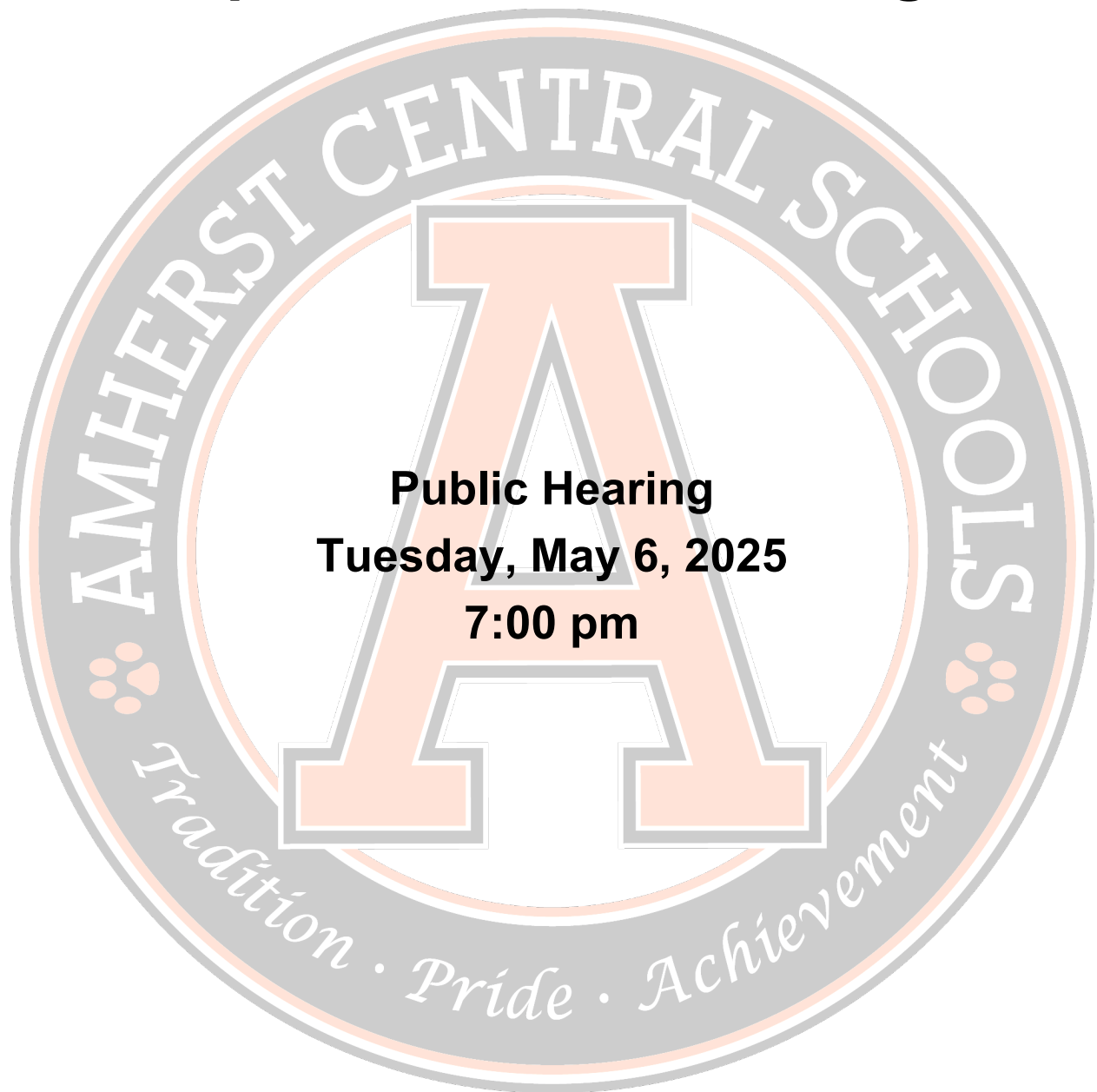

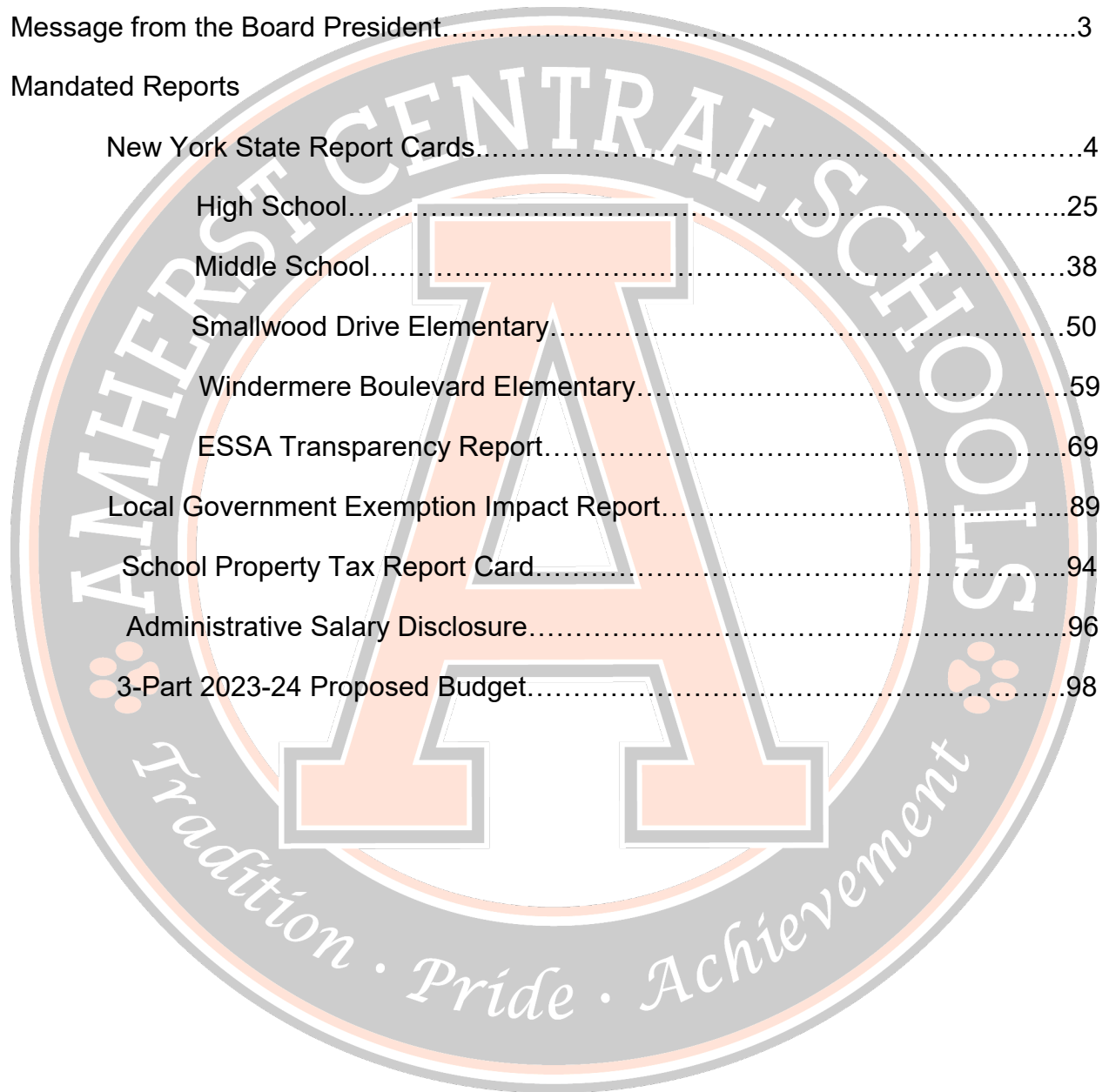

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Our 2025-26 Budget Message

The Amherst Central School District presents a fiscally responsible tax cap compliant budget proposal to our community. The development of this budget began several years ago as part of a multi-year, long-range forecast; an approach that allows the school board to consider not only the immediate needs for the district, but also to anticipate the impact these decisions may have in the future.

The 2025-26 budget includes:

- A tax cap levy increase of \$939,336. For 2025-26, the calculated tax levy limit for Amherst Central School District is 2.33%.
- An estimated tax rate increase of \$0.30 thousand of assessed valuation, based on prior year town-wide assessments.
- A budget-to-budget increase of 3.66%.

We present this budget proposal to the community with confidence that it meets the school district's mission to prepare all students to excel in a dynamic world while being responsive to the needs of our taxpayers. 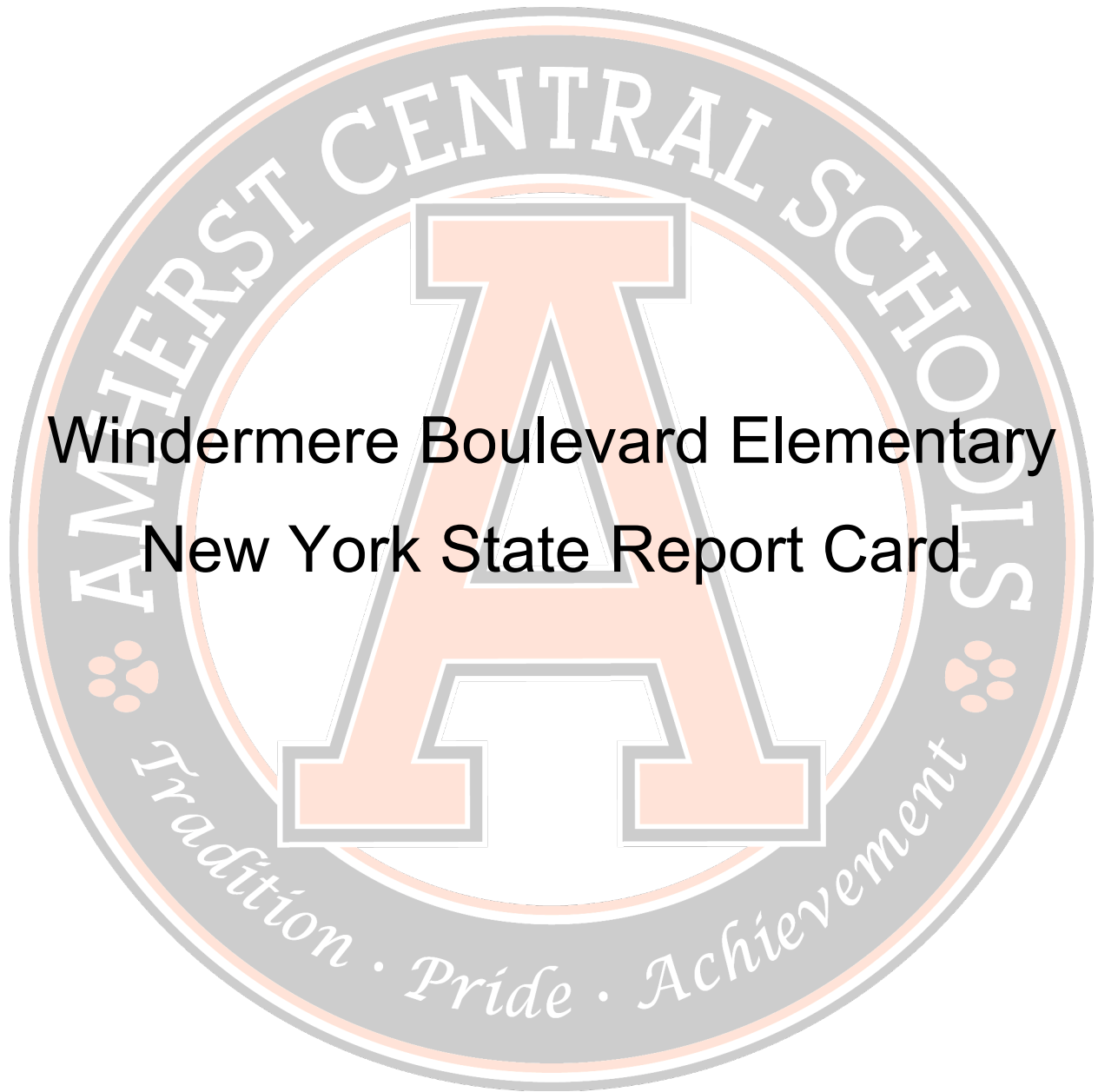

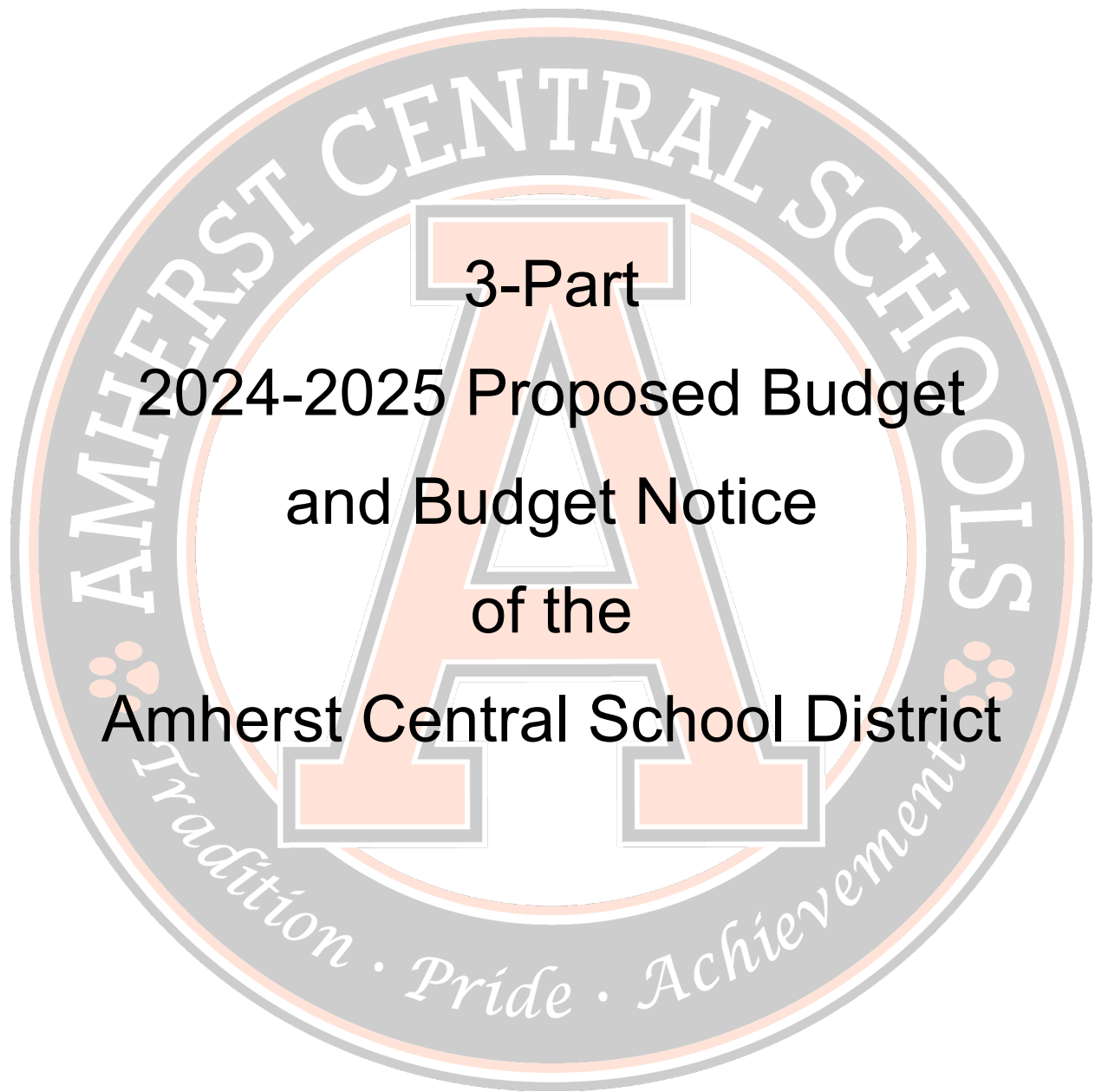
