## About Port Jefferson EMS

Established in 1959, the membership of the Port Jefferson EMS is a volunteer/career EMS agency located in Suffolk County, New York, approximately 50 miles east of New York City.

Port Jefferson EMS provides emergency medical service to a population of approximately 30,000 citizens who reside in a 16 square mile area of Suffolk County.

Port Jefferson EMS offers an array of services, including ground emergency medical care and transportation, NYS EMT training, BLS and ALS continued education, and safety training.

## Education

Port Jefferson EMS will train new members to become NYS certified EMT's in our EMS Academy located at our building. Those that already hold their EMT card are offered other trainings and CME courses. The organization also keeps our members up to date on changes to New York State protocol changes and trainings. Port Jefferson EMS and its members continually strive to stay educated and informed.

## College Student Membership

Student Membership is open to all full-time college students. Student membership is a 12-month membership for those students who reside in Suffolk, Nassau, and Queens. Those students that live outside of Nassau, Suffolk, or Queens ride while in school and are excused from riding during winter and summer break.



## Membership Requirements for both High School & College Students

- Complete Pre-Membership requirements including a background/drug screen, CPAT, physical, and driver's license.
- Become a NYS EMT if you do not already hold a certification.
- **High School Students Ride 1 – 6-hour shift per week (no later than 10pm)**
- Attend 2 standbys per year.
- Attend 1 event per year.
- Take required online trainings
- Maintain an EMT and CPR Certification
- Maintain a 2.5 GPA or higher and provide an unofficial transcript.

- Gaining clinical, hands-on experience in the medical field
- Gaining clinical hours to put towards experience on higher education applications
- Supportive community of peers interested in the same field of study
- Create contacts within the medical field
- Developing skills beyond the medical field including decision making, communication, and self-confidence

## Bunk-In Program

Port Jefferson EMS offers a Bunk-In Membership for Undergraduate College Students. The Bunk-In Membership includes free room and board in exchange for riding hours to college student members. To be eligible for the Bunk-In Membership, you must be a cleared College
