

BOARD COMMITTEES

The Board shall have the following standing committees and any others it deems necessary:

- Academic Affairs
- Buildings and Maintenance
- Community Relations
- Finance
- School and Human Resources

The chair of the Board shall designate at least three members who will assist the Superintendent of Schools and/or their designee(s) in facilitating the work of the committee. Each group of facilitators may appoint a group leader who will report on the work of the committee at the regular school board meetings.

Even with the presence of a quorum, no committee decision shall be binding on the School Board. The responsibility of a committee is to provide information and/or make recommendations to the full School Board at a regular School Board meeting for consideration of action or adoption. The provisions of NH RSA 91-A shall apply, as appropriate, for all standing committees.

Special committees and delegations shall also be appointed by the Chair of the Board and approved by a vote of a majority of the Board.
