Now that we are about to start the fourth quarter, we wanted to take this opportunity to encourage students to talk with their families and review their progress in their World Language classes. This is the perfect time for students to reflect on their effort and create goals for themselves as they prepare for final World Language exams – called FLACS exams.

As you know, your child is currently enrolled in a World Language class and the credit for this course counts toward their high school graduation requirements. In June they will complete the FLACS A Exam, which is a proficiency-based test that will assess your child's progress through speaking, listening, reading, and writing. Please know that the exam is just as important as a Regents Exam, and it is critical that students are successful to progress to the next level of language learning in high school.

Next month, your child will take the first part of the FLACS exam which consists of three required speaking tasks administered by their classroom teacher. The written parts of the test take place on **Monday, June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2025**.
