201 Transforming Conflict – Restoration and Repair (\$200 – Includes light breakfast, lunch and resources)

Conflict is an inevitable and natural part of being human and existing within a community. In this session, participants will explore perspectives on conflict that will help them to see it as an opportunity for deepening relationships and for transformation using restorative approaches. After all, as Malidoma Somé says, "Conflict is the spirit of the relationship asking itself to deepen." Restorative approaches help us to slow down, listen, and understand the root cause of conflict so that it might be addressed more meaningfully and to prevent reoccurrence. Participants will leave with strategies and tools for holding restorative conversations and gain confidence in using restorative processes such as formal conferencing to address various types of harm.
