


#### Communication








## **Morning Drop-off**

## **Upper School Lot:**


- ALL cars must be registered; sticker in window
- Park in a numbered space, first-come/first-served
- No parallel parking in drop-off spots
- No parking in visitor, disabled, or 15-minute spots

#### **Farmhouse Gravel Lot:**


Park in any spot that does not block another car




