5830 PUPIL FUND RAISING

The Board of Education does not allow solicitation of funds by and from the pupils of this district in order to protect pupils from unnecessary pressures and the instructional program from disruption.

"Pupil fund raising" means the solicitation and collection of money by pupils, on or off school premises, for any purpose associated directly or indirectly with the school district or under circumstances in which the solicitors are identified as pupils of this district.

Extra curricular activities are a valuable part of every school. Very often parents, students, coaches, teachers and administrators look to secure funds to provide a broad range of activities. All fund raising activities are to be looked upon with disfavor.

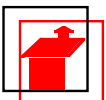
No pupil will be permitted to solicit and collect money for fund raising activities for on or off school premises.

If a special circumstance develops and fund raising seems to be the only viable solution; a complete description of the event, the methods of collection, the names of administrators and teachers involved, description or sample(s) of the product(s) to be sold are to be sent to the building principal for approval. No fund raising may take place until the building principal gives written approval.

The building principal will then forward the information to the Assistant Superintendent at Central Office for information and file.

No school district administrators are allowed to be officers in parent organizations. Teachers and other staff are encouraged to be part of the organization but are advised not to become officers of the organizations. Honorary officers or designations are acceptable.
