7480 MOTOR VEHICLES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

The Board of Education requires that no automobiles or vehicles of any kind may park in any of the school yards of the public schools of this district without permission from the building principal. Any vehicles violating this regulation except in times of snow emergencies shall be removed from the premises and the costs of removal charged to the owner of the vehicle.

All members of the Police Department of the City of Bayonne are authorized to enter at any time of the day or night upon the property and in the buildings of the public schools owned by this Board in order to remove unauthorized automobiles or vehicles on the premises as aforesaid.

All complaints for trespassing or any other law violations that are required by the Police Department to be signed in the name of and on behalf of this Board shall be signed by any Trustee, any official of this Board, any principal, or any employee of this Board assigned to a building where a violation is being committed.
