

Guidelines for Dress-Down Days

Throughout the year, MPCS students in all grades will have the opportunity to participate in “dress-down” days. The guidelines for these days for all grades are listed below.

DRESS-DOWN DAYS REQUIREMENTS*

- On special dress-down days, attire must be modest and school-appropriate*
- Clothes cannot be worn too baggy, too loose, or too tight
- Tops must have sleeves and fully cover midriff (no crop-tops)
- Jeans and pants should be worn at the waist and fit appropriately
- Jeans with no rips/holes
- No cut-offs
- No political or social movement statements or logos
- No inappropriate logos or advertisements
- No pajamas; flannel pants acceptable
- BOYS: Adult shorts must have at least a 7-inch inseam
- GIRLS: Leggings must be paired with a shirt that covers bottom. No shorts or skirts for upper school.
- If not adhering to these guidelines, student must be dressed in normal school uniform

*The administration reserves the right to require students to change clothes if the attire is deemed inappropriate.
