2025-2026 Montessori School Supply List

Elementary 1 (Levels 1, 2 & 3)

All EI students need these supplies:

- 2 large erasers (NO pencil top erasers)
- 1 box of colored pencils 24 count
- 1 box of markers
- 1 large box of tissues
- 1 box of sandwich size zipper bags (1st grade)
- 1 wide ruled loose leaf paper (2nd grade)
- 1 box of gallon size zipper bags (2nd grade)
- 1 box of quart zipper bags (3rd grade)
- 4 small glue sticks OR 1 bottle of school glue
- 24 Ticonderoga Pencils (these are better quality than the others and will last longer)
- 1 water bottle (to be kept in locker)
- 1 pair of inexpensive indoor shoes (to be worn in the classroom)
- \$5 for fleece & field trips

All first time E1 students will need the following list of supplies. <u>Be sure these are labeled with your child's name.</u>

All returning E1 students will need the following list of supplies but may reuse items from last year, if in good working condition, including last year's notebooks, if they still have empty pages.

1 plastic box (lid not needed)—This will be your child's storage box for E1 & E2. This box must fit into a wooden cubby that is 10 ³/₄" wide by 13" high by 18" deep. Please buy as large of a box as possible that will fit within those dimensions. There will NOT be boxes for sale in the office.
 If you struggle to find a box, the Up & Up Large Storage Bins from Target will work.



- 1 Fiskars child-size scissors
- 1 rigid ruler (with inches and centimeters)
- 5 <u>WIDE</u> ruled notebooks blue, green, red, yellow, and black
- 2 <u>plain colored plastic</u> pocket folders (one for school work, one used as take-home folder)
- 1 large backpack or school bag
- 1 insulated cooler or lunch box (if bringing lunch from home)
- 1 pair of inexpensive headphones to work with ipad



Elementary II (Levels 4 & 5)

These items will be set aside to be used by the classroom all year.

- 1 package of graph paper—4th grade ONLY
- 1 box of tissues—4th grade ONLY
- 1 package of sticky notes—5th grade ONLY
- 1 package of 8 ½ " x 11" loose leaf lined paper— 5th grade ONLY
- 2 big erasers (the pink kind!)
- 4 glue sticks
- 2—12 packs of pencils (#2) NO pens or mechanical pencils, please
- \$5 for field trips

Clearly labeled with your child's name:

- 4 Plastic, pocket folder with brads. One labeled with child's name and the words "take home folder" on the cover (different colors-if possible)
- 2 Spiral notebooks (different colors-if possible)

Label each with your child's name:

1 plastic box (lid not needed)—This will be your child's storage box for E1 & E2. This box must fit in to a wooden cubby that is 10 ¾" wide by 13" high by 18" deep. Please buy as large of a box as possible that will fit within those dimensions.

There will NOT be boxes for sale in the office.

- 1 plastic pencil sharpener (with "cover" to catch shavings)
- 1 quality scissors (child-size may be too small!)

- 1 clear protractor
- 1 large backpack or school bag
- 1 insulated cooler or lunch box (if bringing lunch from home)
- 1 pair of tie shoes for gym, if not wearing tennis shoes that day

- 1 travel size pillow 12" x 16" or smaller

- 1 washable child-size blanket (no larger than 36" X
