We are pleased to let you know that, once again, Silverdale are able to offer a range of after-school clubs for the Summer Terms. The focus of our sports clubs shifts to summer sports next term – with Athletics and Cricket high on the agenda! The summer also sees the return of our very popular 'Girls Football' on Mondays.

This year we are including the full range of clubs on this newsletter, including some that are provided by external coaches/sports clubs. Where clubs are provided by members of school staff we are pleased to say we are able to run them at no cost to parents. In some cases, we are also able to use some of the school's 'Sports Premium' funding to make some other clubs free for children. If you'd like to book one of the clubs offered by external providers, we have included the links on this newsletter for you arrange this directly with the club provider. If you have any question about those clubs please approach the club provider directly.

Most clubs are voluntary – for children and teachers!

We rely heavily on members of staff volunteering to run after-school clubs – it is not part of the normal school day and our teachers are not paid extra for running them! So where a club runs, it is purely because a member of staff wants to provide the opportunity for our children to enjoy an extra-curricular activity.
