

# **Basketball Camp for Girls**

Athletes will be instructed in every aspect of the game of basketball in a fun-filled environment. Each clinic will include skill enhancement drills and team play. Here's a brief summary of what you'll get out of these clinics:

Improve Your Ball handling-Considerable time will be spent on your dribbling and passing skills –- allowing you to reduce turnovers, handle any game situation, improve decision making, and improve overall ball handling skill.

Improve Your 1 on 1 Moves-You will learn how to beat your defender off the dribble, when to attack, how to create space, and how to develop a more explosive first move. In today's game, so many players misuse the dribble. They use it and lose their advantage against the defense. You will learn how to effectively use the dribble and cover more space with fewer dribbles at a faster pace. Improve Confidence-During the clinics, the instructors will teach the mental aspects of the game, help you build confidence, and become more aggressive. You will learn how to train your mind, not just physical skills.

Improve Decision Making-You will improve your ability to think and act in decisive ways. The unique decision making drills and skills will help you perform under pressure at the highest level. Improve Shooting-Shooting is a critical skill to be an effective player. You'll learn the keys to effective shooting and experience a variety of shooting drills to help you improve accuracy and ability to score points.

Become More Aggressive-One of the biggest benefits to the training clinics is the development of a confident attacking mindset. The drills, tools, and knowledge you'll receive at these clinics will help you become more aggressive and assertive in games.

Improve Speed & Agility-Throughout the clinics, the instructors will integrate speed and agility drills to help you improve defense, your first step, and overall agility.

Finishing Moves–With a ball in your hands throughout most of the clinics, you'll get opportunities to improve your finishing moves and ability to finish at the basket. You'll learn what to do with the ball after you beat your defender and how to score more points.

We will address technical, tactical and applied aspects of basketball that will help a player develop their game beyond the level they are currently at and have fun along the way!

### NYS Safe Boating and Personal Watercraft Safety Class

This course is taught by a New York State Certified Educator and meets the NYS requirements for a Personal Watercraft (PWC) Boating Safety course. It is intended to provide a basic knowledge of safe and legal boating practices. This is an 8-hour instructor led workshop, which includes a textbook and a 50 question multiple choice exam, which you MUST pass. Satisfactory completion will earn you an official completion certificate, is approved by the AASBLA and meets education requirements for states with boater education laws. Course completion is good for life and is recognized by the US Coast Guard. Participants must be over 10 years of age at the beginning of course. This certificate may also entitle you to a 15% discount annually on your watercraft insurance. The fee includes all books, materials and final exam. The state charges \$10.00 for the certificate which will be paid separately – details given during class. The registration fee DOES NOT include the state certificate and is paid directly to NY upon completion of the course.

\*Registering for this class is a TWO-STEP process: If you have not already done so, you must also register on the NYS Website. You will provide your information for the upcoming Boating Safety Class by registering. After you do, you'll get an email confirming that your information has been completed. #### Tuesday, July 29



This is one of a few remaining estates with a Tudor Mansion and formal public gardens in the United States. Built in 1887, Sonnenberg Gardens includes a 40-room Mansion and 17 other estate structures offering visitors a glimpse of what life was like in the late 19th century. The 50-acre estate boats 9 formal gardens representing many cultures in historic periods. Our visit includes a SHORT MANSION TOUR & TIME TO TOUR THE GARDENS. There is limited trolley space available for those who many find the walk through the gardens challenging. Please advise if you would like to reserve the tram - limited to 14 people. Next, ENJOY A RELAXING CRUISE ON CANANDAIGUA LAKE ABOARD THE CANANDAIGUA LADY. The Canandaigua Lady is a 19th century steamboat replica and an authentic double-decker paddlewheeler. Docking on the Northern Shoreline of Canandaigua Lake since 1989, the Lady is a proud successor to locally famous steamboats that operated on the Finger Lakes between 1820 and 1930. At one time, there were 19 steamboats that operated as the primary means of transportation, as there were no roads along the lake at the time. The Canandaigua Lady boat tour is an attraction that is memorable for all! BOX LUNCH is included on board the CANANDAIGUA LADY PADDLEWHEELER. AN ICE CREAM TREAT is included at SCOOPS ICE CREAM this afternoon.
