A. Math Textbook Purchase

A brief conversation was held clarifying the timeline for adoption of the new curriculum at each grade level

Although the enVision curriculum is being adopted for grades K-5, only Grades 4-5 teachers will begin implementation with the 2025-26 school year

K-3 teachers will begin the adoption of the enVision Math program in 2026-27 to give them additional time to master the new ELA program

Grade 6 and 7 teachers did not feel that the enVision Math Curriculum met all of the requirements to align with the New York State standards, and they continue to work with the Director of Curriculum & Instruction to review other curricula

Upon the recommendation of Dr. Genelle Morris, Superintendent of Schools, to approve the adoption of the enVision Mathematics Curriculum, textbooks, and programs, for Grades K-5, Copyright 2024, published by Savvas.


