

Regular season has ended for many teams and post-season play is right around the corner. Girls Golf played in the Puget Sound League Tournament yesterday and the Boys Team is playing in the Puget Sound League Tournament today. Boys and Unified Soccer open District post-season action this Saturday (5/10/25). Baseball opens District play next Tuesday (5/13/25) and Fastpitch Softball opens District play next Thursday (5/15/25).

Here's everything that's fit to print in Silas Athletics:

Baseball

Our Varsity Baseball team closed out their regular season with two games. Last Wednesday (4/30/25), our Rams hosted the River Ridge Hawks here at Silas High School. Our Rams prevailed in a well-pitched game, 3 to 1.

Last Friday, our Rams traveled to North Seattle to take on the Ingram Rams. Our Rams lost to their Rams 8 to 1.

Our Varsity Rams closed out their regular season with an overall record of 12-8 and crafted a 10-6 record in Puget Sound League play. They finished 2nd in the Narrows Division of the Puget Sound League.

Next up for our Rams is the West Central/Southwest Washington 3A Baseball District Championships. District play begins on Tuesday May 13th and runs through Saturday May 17th. This 16-team tournament will identify the seven teams that will advance to the WIAA State Baseball Championships.

All first round District games will be played at the higher seed's venue.

From the Best Guess Department:

Silas would likely be the #8, #9, or the #10 seed in the tournament, based on the WIAA RPI rankings. Here's how things might shake out based on seeding:

- If Silas is awarded the #8 seed, they will open the tournament on the road against the #1 seed in the tournament (most likely Decatur or Gig Harbor). If they are seeded #8, Silas is playing in the double elimination portion of the tournament.
- If Silas is awarded the #9 or #10 seed, they would host their first round against either the #15 or #16 seed (most likely Timberline, Bellarmine Prep, or Mountain View). This would be a winner advance loser out game. If they were to win their first game, their second round game would be on the road and also is a winner advance loser out game.

As tournament action progresses, winner bracket games (Semi-Finals and Finals) will be played at Auburn High School. Consolation Round games will be played at Auburn Riverside High School. More details to come when seeding for the Championship takes place.

On Friday (4/28/25), our Rams hosted the Mount Tahoma T-Birds in a doubleheader to close out their regular season. Our Rams swept the T-Birds, capturing both games 16 to 5 and 8 to 7. Here are the highlights from Coach Johnson:

The District Championships will be held in Lacey at the Regional Athletic Complex (aka RAC) on Thursday May 15th and Saturday May 17th. The entire Tournament will be played at this venue.

From the Best Guess Department:

Using the WIAA RPI Rankins, Silas will likely be the #11, #12, or the #13 seed in the tournament. Here's our best guess on how things might shake out based on what's to come:

- The District Championships is a double elimination tournament. If our Rams were to win their first two games in the tournament, they would qualify for State. If they were to lose one of their first two games, they would have to win out (up to three games) to advance to the 2025 WIAA Gesa Credit Union 3A State Fastpitch Softball Championships.
- Our Rams will most likely play the #4, #5, or #6 seed which most likely will be Timberline, Auburn Mountainview, or Central Kitsap in the first round.

We will share when and against whom our Rams play once the seeding committee completes their work.

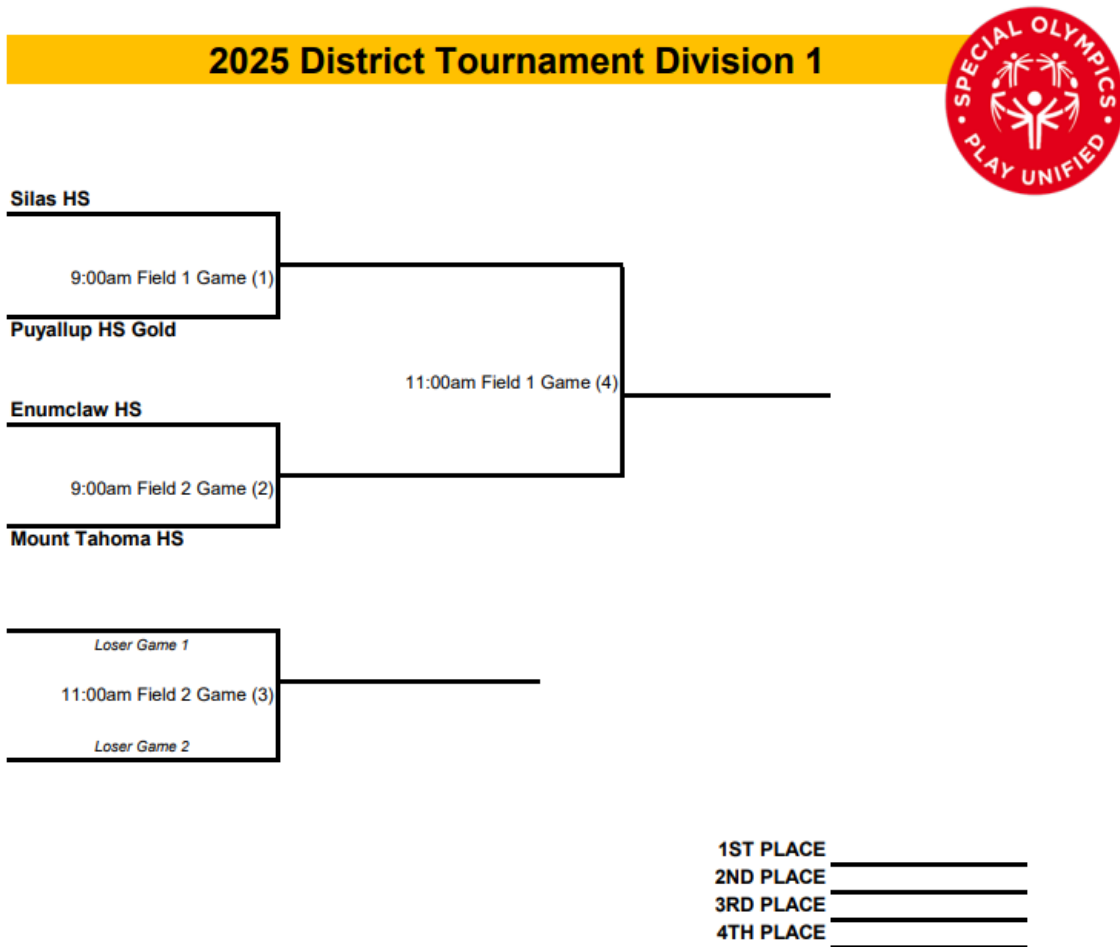
Soccer – Unified
