Charles County Public Schools is excited to invite you to participate in our summer Professional Learning opportunities for educators.

This summer, CCPS is offering workshops in key instructional areas for teachers and administrators. Some workshops are also targeted for instructional assistants. Mandatory Trainings are highlighted in pink. For additional information regarding mandatory training, please refer to the attached email. Mandatory training pay will be distributed in late fall.

Many workshops offer a stipend. Participants must complete the entire workshop to be eligible for credit or stipend. Workshops that offer a stipend will be clearly marked and normally include the certificated pay amount. The stipend for salaried IAs will be adjusted to \$17 per hour and the stipend for hourly or temporary IAs will be adjusted to \$16.25 per hour.

Subject: Mandatory Summer Professional Learning - 2025

The Blueprint for Maryland's Future mandates that each Local Education Agency (LEA) provide all teachers with the professional learning system developed by the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) by June 20, 2026. Teachers are required to <u>undergo training on</u> eight specific topics as identified in the Maryland Code, Education Article §6-1011. In compliance with this legislation, Charles County Public Schools (CCPS) has scheduled professional learning days in August for the required training sessions.

Following negotiations between Charles County Public Schools and the Education Association of Charles County, it has been agreed that there will be professional learning days compensated at the per diem rate. Therefore, teachers are expected to attend a four-hour professional learning session on either Thursday, August 14, or Friday, August 15, 2025.
