***ALL STUDENTS' VEHICLES PARKED ON SCHOOL BOARD
PROPERTY ARE SUBJECT TO SEARCH***

A fee of \$20.00 must be paid to obtain a parking permit. There is a \$10.00 charge for replacement decals. The student and parent must sign the parking contract stating that they both understand and will adhere to the school regulations regarding the driving and parking on school property. School safety and regulations must be observed. Regulations for driving and parking vehicles to school are as follows:

1. Parking permits are issued to seniors and juniors who meet the requirements. Freshmen and sophomores are not eligible for parking privileges without approval from the Principal or designee.
- 2. Students leaving campus without authorization may have their driving privileges revoked immediately, with no refund.**
3. Students are responsible for knowing who is in their vehicle. Any student found taking an unauthorized person off campus will have their privileges revoked immediately, with no refund.
4. Students found with fraudulent parking permits will have privileges revoked immediately, and may be subject to disciplinary action by the administration.
5. All students who are issued a parking permit must hang the tag from their rear view mirror. Hang tags are non-transferable. Tags cannot be loaned to others and tags cannot be purchased for others.
6. If a student who has been issued a parking permit needs to drive a different vehicle to school, they must contact the Main Office upon arriving at the school to give vehicle information.
7. Rockbridge County High School requires that ALL students who park on campus between the hours of 8:00 AM and 3:40 PM have a current parking permit.
8. Students are not to remain in their vehicles upon arriving on school property. Immediately upon arrival, both the driver and passenger(s) of the vehicle must leave the vehicle and exit the parking lot. The student parking lot will remain off limits to students during the school day. A pass will be required to go into the parking lot during school hours.

9. Students will park in areas designated for students only. Vehicles parked in unauthorized areas will be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense.
10. Students walking from the student lot to the school must use the provided crosswalks for safety purposes.
11. Students who are assigned a numbered spot, must park in that parking spot.
12. Students are responsible for the security of their vehicles and the contents left in them. All vehicle windows are to be rolled up and doors locked. Drivers park on school grounds at their own risk and neither Rockbridge County High School nor Rockbridge County Public Schools accepts responsibility for damage or theft.
13. Any problems should be directed to the School Resource Officer or the Main Office immediately.
14. Administration reserves the right to revoke parking privileges at any time for inappropriate behavior.
15. Students who are found to be spinning tires, parking on the timbers or throwing trash in the parking lots will have their parking privileges revoked, with no refund.
- 16. Students accumulating 10 unexcused tardies, 10 unexcused absences, or any combination of unexcused tardies and unexcused absences totaling 10, will have their parking privileges revoked for the remainder of the 2024-2025 school year, with no refund.**

***I, the undersigned student and parent, have read and agree to follow the rules listed above, that are associated with having a parking permit.**

*** I understand that parking on campus is a privilege that can be revoked or suspended for any violation of these rules or any unsafe driving on campus.**

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT PARKING PASS APPLICATION

Va. Code § 22.1-205.1: Each public high school shall require any student who applies to obtain a pass to park a vehicle on school property to provide evidence that the student possesses a valid driver's license or driver privilege card. The Department of Education shall develop, and each public high school shall utilize, a standard application form for students to use to obtain a pass to park a vehicle on school property.

Teen Driving Restrictions

Virginia's driving restrictions are not meant to penalize teen drivers, but to help them stay safe while they gain valuable driving experience. Studies have found that these restrictions work to reduce the number of car crashes among young drivers.

Curfew Restrictions

If you are under age 18, Virginia law prohibits you from driving between midnight and 4 A.M. except when driving:

- to or from a place of business where you are employed;
- to or from an activity that is supervised by an adult and is sponsored by a school or by a civic, religious, or public organization;
- with a licensed spouse age 18 or older, parent or other adult acting in loco parentis who is occupying the front passenger seat,
- in case of an emergency, including responding to emergency calls as a volunteer firefighter or rescue squad personnel.

Restrictions on the Number of Passengers

If you are under age 18, you may carry only one passenger under age 21, unless accompanied by a licensed parent, or other adult acting in place of a parent, in the front passenger seat. However, after you have held your license for one year, you may carry up to three passengers under age 21 in the following situations:

- Travel to and from a school-sponsored activity;
- A licensed driver 21 or older is in the front passenger seat; or
- In case of an emergency.

Learner's permit holders may not carry more than one passenger under age 18.
(Passenger restrictions do not apply to family members)

Cellular Telephone Restrictions

§ 46.2-818.2. Virginia's cellular telephone law prohibits any person from holding a handheld personal communications device while driving a moving motor vehicle on the highways in the Commonwealth.
