As the weather is becoming consistently nice and we have more students riding their bikes / walking to school, I would like to review arrival / dismissal procedures to keep our students safe:

When entering the school for drop off, please pull as far up as possible. We have entrances near the auditorium, main entrance, and gym. Please do not stop at the gym entrance if there is space available in front of you.

Please note that staff and/or student parking lots should not be used for student drop-offs or pick-ups.

Crosswalks: If driving, please be on the lookout for students and staff near the established crosswalks around the campus, especially in the drop-off lane. All vehicles should stop if there is someone waiting to cross.

Speed Limit: The speed limit on campus is **15 mph**.

If your child is riding their bike to school, we ask that you encourage them to wear a helmet.
