NEW PARENT PICK-UP PROCEDURES

UPDATED MAY 2025

In an effort to make parent/guardian pick up safer and more efficient, there will be a **NEW** procedure starting. Please take some time to view and read through our new parent pick-up directions. As we work through this new procedure, I will make notes for any potential or additional changes for the 2025-2026 school year.

NEW CHANGES


- 1. Students will be released around 3:10-3:15pm. Mrs. Sardo will begin calling the first 8-10 cars promptly at 3:15pm.
- 2. As stated in the past, I am requesting that ALL parents/guardians remain in their vehicles, follow the pick-up route, and remain patient. Unless your child needs support getting into the vehicle (i.e. booster seat, assistance securing safety seatbelts etc...) you should remain in your vehicle at all times. This also help to prevent any safety issues from possibly occurring. Those parents/guardians securing students, please be timely and considerate of the process.
- 3. Please review the attached pick-up procedure map. There will be a new entrance for all parents/guardians that choose to pick-up in person (Main Office). Please make note of the change. Please DO NOT enter the first entrance off of Clark Mills Rd.
- 4. If you would like to continue to pick your child up in person and do not want to wait in the car-line, you may still do so but will need to report to the main office. There will be no further 'in person pickups' or waiting at the gymnasium entrance. This area will be designated for carline pickups only. Please be patient as we identify those students who will now need to transition to the main office to sign out rather than reporting to the gymnasium/cafeteria. Again, I am kindly asking you to consider waiting in the carline for pick-up as our vestibule is on the smaller side. If you are walking home with your child, please report to the main office for sign out. Parents/guardians always have the option to use/request school provided transportation as well.

Hart's Hill Elementary School will be partnering with the American Heart Association between May 27th - June 5th to raise awareness and funds to support heart health. 

D.E.A.R. INITIATIVE


<u>Dates:</u> March 3, 2025 - April 12, 2025

As a school, we met our independent reading goal of 90 minutes!


