This summer, there are some important things you can do to help your child succeed in the future.

- Play and engage in meaningful conservations with your child every day.
- Read to and encourage your child to decode simple words. Ask questions, make predictions, and make text-to-life connections as you read.
- Notice high frequency words while reading.
- Help your child develop a sense of working and solving problems independently.
- Practice getting and staying organized.
- Encourage your child to draw, cut and write often.

Attached please find some high frequency words to practice over the summer. Please note that these are covered throughout the school year in kindergarten and need not be mastered when the year begins. Feel free to make this fun by creating a game, a scavenger hunt, find them in the books you are reading to them or simply checking off the words as your child masters them.

Our End of the Year program is Wednesday, May 14<sup>th</sup>, in the Chotin Center at 8:00 a.m. The children will meet on the stairs in front of the Chotin Center with their parents at 7:45 a.m.. Parents will wait outside until we are in our places for our performance. The children are to wear their school uniforms.
