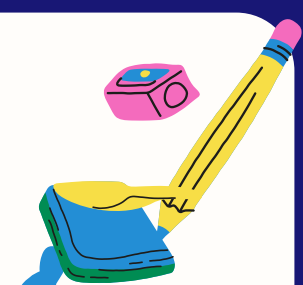




# HGMS 7th GRADE Classroom News Week 4/28-5/2 (1) & 5/5-5/9 (2)
