Academic & Instructional Quality

2024-2025

- New 7-12 Mathematics and ELA Academic Improvement Plan developed and implemented.
- New courses offered at high school included:
 - Taking Flight 1 – Drone Theory and Design
 - Taking Flight 2 – Drone Flight and Navigation
- New courses offered in 7th and 8th grade for additional instructional support in reading and mathematics.
- New differentiated instructional tools for reading and mathematics in grades 7-8 (iXL) and grades 9-12 (Study Island and Exact Path).

2025-2026

- New courses will be offered at high school including: CHS Biology, Social Justice, World at War, American Pop Culture, American Innovation and Entrepreneurs
- New computer technology courses will be implemented offered at elementary schools

2024-2025
