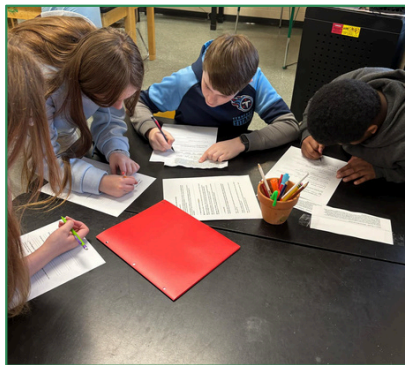
Falcon pride stands the test of time! The LCHS Class of 2006 reunited to celebrate memories, friendships, and their Falcon legacy.
