My driver education offers students a comprehensive; four phase program that concentrates on physical, mental, social, and emotional skill training. The program consists of instruction hours in online Moodle course, awareness information online, and on road instruction. This program will focus on the skills needed for a student driver to become a safer, more responsible decision maker as it relates to the highway transportation system. My goal is to provide a good foundation for a lifetime of safe driving and that students will gain skills and the ability to contribute to the improvement of traffic safety in our community and the State of New York.

Prerequisite:

I would like students to have passed 4 high school classes and be 16, with a learners permit by the first day of class. This helps to demonstrate a readiness and maturity level for this fast paced, high level skill training.

Student Outcomes:

1. Develop knowledge, skills, and attitude necessary to become a safe, minimal risk, responsible driver.
2. Learn how to identify, predict, decide, and execute in a manner that develops the behavior and mental skills necessary to help manage risk.
3. Have a working overview of the driving task and skills needed to navigate the complex highway transportation system and become a safe driver.
4. Learn how to create various strategies; SIPDE, Process, The Smith System, and Zone Control Driving System, to process and apply these accepted concepts into safe driving behaviors.
5. Develop sound habits for searching and managing space, visibility, and traction problems.
6. Help students make sound decisions about driving-related behaviors, controlling emotions, attitude, distractions, drowsiness, drugs, and deadly driving.

Course facts:

- 15 Sessions, you will complete 1 session per day while in Driver Ed
- All Sessions and all assignments need to be complete to earn a certificate.
- You must complete the sessions the day they are open, no make-up sessions will be scheduled.
- You must pass online course work and BTW (Behind the Wheel) with a 65%
- All activity while in Moodle course is tracked and timed, if you are not doing the work, you will not be eligible to earn the certificate.
- As you complete each assignment within the sessions, which means you read the lessons completely, watched all the videos and answered all the questions, YOU WILL ALWAYS BE PROMPTED TO END THE ASSIGNMENT AND SUBMIT YOUR GRADE.

Check your gradebook after every assignment is completed to be sure you submitted your grade to your gradebook. If there is not a grade, you need to go back and submit the grade upon completion. NO GRADE MEANS NO CREDIT.

You must have your license/permit with you every session!!

Please be sure to plan around scheduled times if hours are not completed and you will not pass this course or receive a certificate.

We are fitting a lot of material in a brief period; there is no time or room for missed hours to be made up.
