WHAT IS T&E CARE? (www.tecare.org)

Tredyffrin & Easttown Care is an **all-volunteer** organization that lends a hand to T/E neighbors who are facing difficult or emergency situations. T&E Care offers short term assistance to get a family over a hump. Have you ever faced an eviction or had a PECO shut-off notice? Or maybe your car broke down and you had no money to make a repair? Do you need mental health counseling or dental work, and have no insurance? What if you don't have the money to send your child to summer camp, or buy the required back-to-school supplies? These are just a few examples of the types of situations with which T&E Care lends assistance to neighbors right here in this community.

ASKING FOR HELP

If you are a district family that could use some extra assistance at any point during the year, T&E Care may be able to lend a hand. Please keep in mind that it doesn't pay ongoing expenses – it helps with a specific need. The requestor should be working, actively looking for a job, or have access to monthly income (like social security). It pays bills directly to a vendor. All assistance is confidential but referrals (school counselor, employer, church pastor, etc.) may be needed. Besides paying emergency or specific bills – T&E Care can sometimes offer assistance with school supplies, computers, holiday gifts, holiday meals, summer camp costs, clothes, job coaching, budgeting help, lunch costs, and college mentoring.

GETTING INVOLVED

T&E Care receives no government assistance.
