BVHS Senior Named National Merit Scholarship Award Recipient

Buckeye Valley High School senior William Allen is the recipient of a National Merit Nationwide Foundation Scholarship, according to a recent announcement by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC). This prestigious award, recognizing academic excellence, is awarded to finalists who have demonstrated strong accomplishments, skills, and potential for success in college.

Scholars are selected by a committee of college admissions officers and high school counselors, who review information submitted by both the finalist and their high school. The academic record, including the difficulty level of subjects studied and grades earned; scores from the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT®); contributions and leadership in school and community activities, an essay written by the finalist, and a recommendation written by a high school official are all a part of the selection process.

Allen is among the first group of winners in the 70th Annual National Merit Scholarship Program to be announced this year. In all, about 830 distinguished high school seniors have been awarded corporate-sponsored National Merit Scholarship
