Language Arts Learning Goals:

Big Idea: "Why do people trade with each other?"

Amazing Words: trade, wants, needs, goods, services, community, economy, job, money

*Heart words: your, then, what, know, her, one, sure, where, new, all, says, say

*decode words with /oi/ or /oy/ as in boy, royal, soil, or Detroit

*comprehension: I can recall information from a nonfiction text

*identify the main idea of a text

*differentiate between fiction and nonfiction text

*ask and answer questions from a text

*read nonfiction text and recall information

*use text features to better understand a nonfiction text

*practice narrative writing and opinion writing

Math Learning Goals:

*add single digit numbers to 2 digit numbers by counting on or by "carrying"

*add double digit numbers with and without regrouping

*use place value to do math

*learn multiple methods to solve addition equations

*determine if an addition problem has an extra ten or not
