

SLD Notification for Schools as Required by PI 11.36(6)(c)2

Wisconsin's rule for identifying students with specific learning disabilities (SLD) has changed. No later than December 1, 2013, all initial SLD evaluations of public school students will use information from interventions to make eligibility decisions.

This is to notify you that as of September 1, 2015, initial SLD evaluations at Almond-Bancroft Schools began using information from a student's response to intensive, scientific research based or evidence-based interventions when making special education eligibility decisions.

This change in qualification procedures will be implemented in our district by using a Multi-Level System of Supports. This framework encompasses academics and behaviors and include evidence-based interventions and personalized plans to support students.
