

2. On the day of your physical, please arrive 15 minutes prior to your official time slot to complete pre-physical paperwork.

3. 2025-26 IHSAA Physical Forms will be available at CHS on the day of your physical or you can print one from our website (<u>www.covington.k12.in.us</u>).

4. A parent/guardian must accompany each student-athlete to their appointment to sign paperwork.

5. Student-athletes should report to Door #1 (HS main entrance) for their appointment.
