

Bylaws

SUBJECT: CONSTITUTIONAL OATH OF OFFICE

- a) Newly elected, re-elected or appointed members of the Board of Education shall take the oath of office at the organizational meeting of the Board of Education.
- b) If this is not possible, those elected at the annual election shall take the oath of office by the following July 31. Those elected or appointed other than at the annual election, shall take the oath of office within 30 (thirty) days of their election or appointment.
- c) The oath shall be signed by the member and filed with the District Clerk.
- d) The oath is as follows:

Article 13, Sub-Division 1 of the Constitution of the State of New York.

"I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of New York and that I will faithfully discharge the duties of the office of members of education of Sweet Home Central Schools according to the best of my ability."
