Summary Explanation and Background

Hudson Boudreaux of Bascomb Elementary School and Zaine Reinhart of Hasty ES Fine Arts Academy earned first place at the regional competition and advanced to the state contest earlier this month.

Hudson, a fifth-grader, earned top honors at regions in the Political Science category for his project, "How Have Nuclear Weapons Changed the World?" and at the state fair, earned the Best in Discipline honor for Grades 5-6. Zaine, a fifth-grader in the History category earned top honors at regions for his entry, "How Has Basketball Changed Over the Years?"

Through the annual CCSD Social Studies Fair program, students in grades 5-12 can explore an area of social studies and complete a research project individually or as part of a team. Categories for projects include anthropology, economics, geography, history, political science, and sociology/psychology. Seven students advanced from the district level to the regional competition.
