## **21. 2025-2026 Food Service Management**

That the Board of Education approve the following resolution –

*Be it resolved that the Springfield Board of Education "SFA" approves the renewal of the Food Service Management contract with The Pomptonian, Inc. "FSMC" for the food service operation for 2025-2026.*

1. The FSMC shall receive, in addition to the costs of operation, an administrative/management fee of \$0.2655 per reimbursable meal and meal equivalent to compensate the FSMC for administrative and management costs. This fee shall be billed monthly as a cost of operation. The SFA guarantees the payment of such costs and fee to the FSMC.

Total meals are calculated by adding reimbursable meal pattern meals served and meal equivalents. The number of reimbursable meals served to the children shall be determined by actual count. Cash receipts, other than from sales of reimbursable program meals served to the children, shall be divided by \$4.70 to arrive at an equivalent meal count.

The per meal administrative/management fee of \$0.2655 will be multiplied by total meals.

2. There is no guaranteed financial performance.

3. Total Estimated Cost of Contract:

Total estimated expenses (cost) include food, labor, supplies, other expenses, and FSMC management fee.
