2025 Grades 7 – 8 Summer School

Grades 7- 8 Summer School enables students who have failed a subject to remove deficiencies and be considered for promotion to the next grade. The grade earned in Summer School DOES NOT replace the grade recorded on a student's school record at the end of the year.

Grades 7- 8 Summer School dates are Monday, June 9, 2025 to Wednesday, July 2, 2025.

There will be no in-person option. Students will complete Grades 7 - 8 Summer School from home via the online platform Edgenuity. Students will work 4 hours a day online and have access to a teacher through Google Meet during designated office hours.

8th grade ELA

7th grade Math

8th grade Math

7th grade Science

8th grade Science

7th grade Social Studies

8th grade Social Studies

- \$150 per course

The purpose of the grades 7 – 8 Summer School is to enable students to remove a deficiency in order to be promoted to the next grade level. So that there is no misunderstanding, it is required that both student and parent read the following information and sign this sheet.

1. A student who exceeds twelve (12) hours of absences or does not complete 100% of work and receive a passing actual grade cannot be awarded credit.
2. All students must work in the online learning platform for at least 4 hours per day, Monday – Friday.
