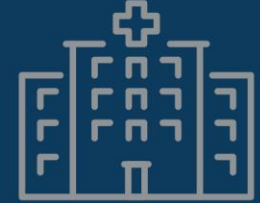

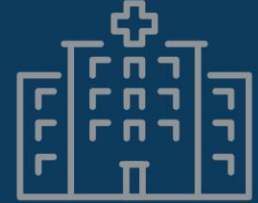


Highlights

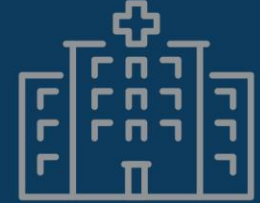
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Our Graduates

- All working in health care or continuing their education in college.



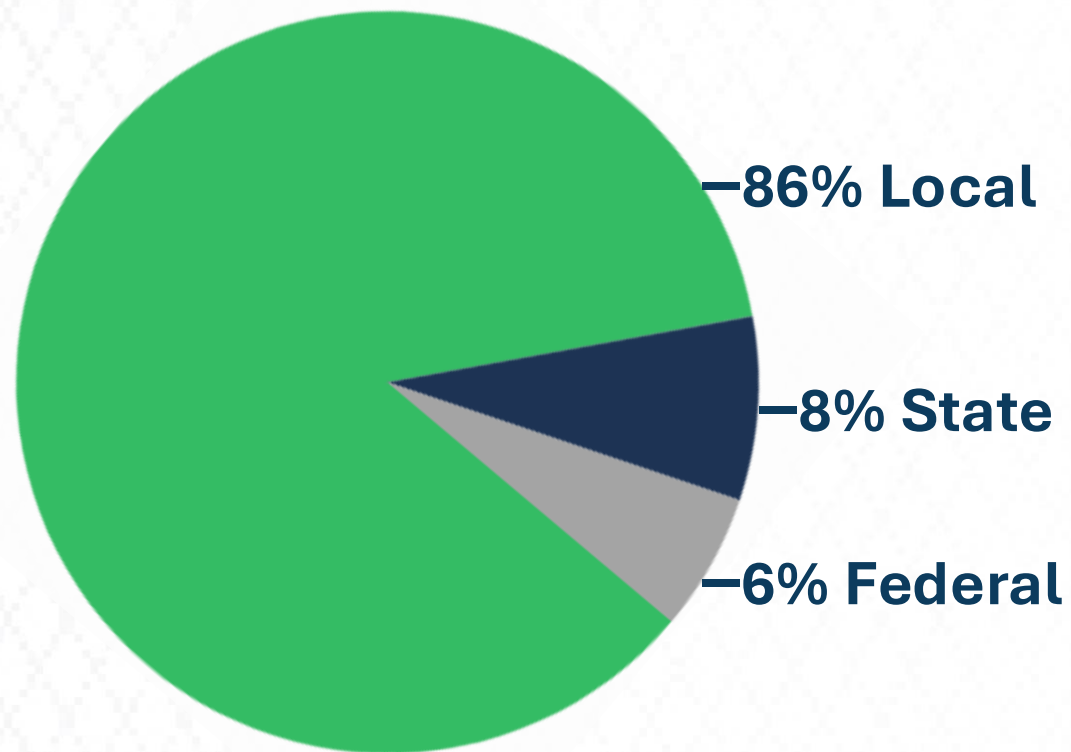

Challenges

Rising Student Demand

- More than 25% of qualified applicants turned away in 2024
- 2025 projected to be nearly 30%
- Limited capacity

Growing Employer Demand

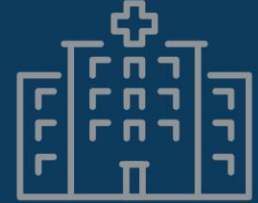
- Increasing need for skilled workers
 - Health care
 - Construction trades

Oklahoma's Projected Employment Growth By 2030

- Nursing: ↑12.2%
- Construction: ↑9.3%

Oklahoma Employment Security Commission

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Feedback from District Voters

- Survey of 400 registered voters in the district
- Nov. 11-13, 2024



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Research Findings

- Top two voter concerns:
 - Education
 - Jobs and the economy
- 86% agree taxes paid to MNTC are a good investment
- 78% in support of \$85 million bond proposal

Most Important Skilled Training to Voters

- **Technical trades**

(e.g., construction, electrical, HVAC, CADD & AMT)

- **Health care**

(e.g., nursing, medical sonography, surgical technology, biomedical and physical therapy)



Student Investment Plan

Election: March 4, 2025

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Total Cost

- \$90 million
- 10-year obligation
- 1.25% property tax increase
- Approx. \$40 per year for average homeowner

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\$33M Technical Trades

New facility for HVAC, Electrical, Carpentry, and Cabinet Making programs
Facility includes safe room



\$25M Healthcare

Expansion and modernization of existing spaces for Nursing, Medical Sonography, Surgical Technology, Biomedical, and Physical Therapy, Medical Assisting, Vet Assisting, AUA, HS Health (CNA), safe rooms



Common space and safe room connecting current Health and IT buildings



\$32M Business Workforce Development Center

New Business Workforce Development Center facility

Expansion of AMT, Cyber Security, Architectural/Mechanical Drafting & Design

Includes technology, equipment, safe rooms
