Graduation Cap Decorating Procedures and Etiquette

Please take into consideration the following rules when decorating your graduation cap. Failure to follow these rules could result in walking the line without a cap at Graduation. At the minimum, you will be required to purchase a new cap if one is available.

- **NO offensive language, sayings, nicknames, pictures or lyrics on cap**
- **NO objects such as signs, stuffed animals, bells, or toys, etc**
- ALL decorations **MUST LAY FLAT** on the cap--**nothing larger than the cap button**. Your cap **CANNOT** make noise (**No bells, horns, or anything that makes noise**)
- Along with the above guidelines **you may (without prior authorization)** decorate your cap to:
 - Recognize the College, University, J.C., U.S. Military Branch, or Tech/Vocational School you will be attending.
- Along with the above guidelines you may use one of the following suggestions for appropriate cap decorations:
 - A “Thank You” to a parent, grandparent, teacher, guardian, or mentor
- **ONLY WITH DIRECT PRIOR APPROVAL** by the Principal **by Friday of the week before graduation**, and within the above guidelines, you may possibly be allowed to use one of the following cap decorations:
 - Inspirational quotes
 - Cultural Representation Items
 - Country colors, Art (i.e. pictures of Frida)
 - Symbols
