

Guardian Visa (Non-Immigrant O) For Parents of Students at Rugby School Thailand

Welcome to Rugby School Thailand

The Guardian Visa (Non-O) is for parents or legal guardians of foreign students under 20 years old who are studying in Thailand on a valid Education Visa (Non-ED). This visa allows a parent to legally reside in Thailand while their child studies at Rugby School Thailand.

Eligibility:

- Must be a parent or legal guardian of a student holding a valid Non-ED Visa.
- The student must be under 20 years old.
- Only one parent is typically granted the Guardian Visa (exceptions require special approval).

Required Documents:

From the Parent/Guardian:

- Passport (valid for at least 6 months).
- Copy of the child's passport and current visa.
- Birth certificate of the student (translated into English/Thai and legalized, showing parent-child relationship).
- Marriage certificate (if applicable).
- Visa application form (TM.87 for application outside Thailand / TM.7 for application within Thailand). - Form can be [downloaded from the immigration website](#)
- Two recent passport-size photos (4x6 cm).
- Proof of financial means
 - The initial application requires a 30-day bank statement showing a minimum balance of 500,000THB for each day prior to the application date.
 - Subsequent renewals require a 90-day bank statement showing a minimum balance of 500,000THB for each day prior to the application date.
- The copies of your Thai bank account book (every page)
- A bank guarantee letter from your Thai bank
- Copy of parent's house registration or rental agreement in Thailand.
- TM.30 (residence notification from landlord or hotel).
- Copy ID card / Copy passport of your landlord
- In the case where you are the owner, please provide as below
 - A copy of Company registration from DBD (Department of business development)
 - A copy of Title deed (Cha-Nod)

From Rugby School Thailand:

- Official letter confirming the student's full-time enrolment.
- Copy of Rugby School Thailand's licence and School registration documents.

Where to Apply:

- **Outside Thailand:** Apply at a Thai Embassy or Consulate (recommended for first-time applications).
- **Inside Thailand:** You may enter on a tourist visa or visa exemption and apply to convert to a Guardian Visa at Thai Immigration (e.g., **Chonburi Immigration Office** for RST).
- Your child must have a valid one-year education visa before you can submit the application

Visa Validity:

- The initial Guardian Visa is valid for **90 days**.
- Can be extended for **1 year** at the Immigration Office.
- Renewable annually as long as the student remains enrolled at **Rugby School Thailand**.

Extension Procedure:

- Submit all documents to the Immigration Office.
- Once approved, a 1-year visa extension is granted.

Important Notes:

- You must report your address to Immigration every 90 days (TM.47).
- You must notify Immigration if your residence changes (TM.30).
- The Guardian Visa is **linked to the child's Non-ED Visa** – any change in the student's visa status may affect the Guardian Visa.
- If both parents wish to stay, special permission must be requested, and justification provided.

RST Visa Service Fees

RST provides visa support services for students and their guardians. The following service fees apply:

- New Education Visa: 15,000 THB
- Education Visa (Transfer or Renewal): 10,000 THB
- Guardian Visa: 10,000 THB
- School Document Pack Only: 1,000 THB



These fees cover the preparation and processing of visa-related documentation, liaison with Immigration, and guidance through the application process.
