Principal's Update - Dr. Shane Christensen

- School Improvement Goals 4 Big goals and Action Cards
 - Action Cards are detailed steps for this year, next year and the 3rd year
 - o Attendance Goal 85% of students are at school. We are currently at 89.9%
 - Discipline Goal PBIS School 95% of students will have 2 or fewer referrals to the office. – We are at 98%.
 - Grade Goals –90% of all our students have As, Bs, and Cs. We are at 89%.
 Aiming for 95% by the end of the school year.
 - Belonging Caring adult survey given 3 times a year. Ask students to name a caring adult in the building. Goals is 99% of all students have an adult they can talk to.
 - Student focus groups from 7th and 8th grade to give feedback and data about their caring adult in the building.
 - Students like the way the school does "soft starts" for the day/class.
 - Lockers are difficult for students.
 - Committee analyzing what needs to be done for a student to be successful.
 - We will be keeping the trapper/binder system for the next school year.
 - Students like their Tiger Time and Tiger Time Teachers.
 - Encore Opportunity for extension and intervention.

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We have made good progress in regards to our Action Cards.

2 Retirees at Indian Hills – Mr. Scott (Math Teacher) - New teacher is a Valley graduate who will be graduating this year. Mr. Alan Muenzenmay – (Math Teacher) – Mr. Evans from Clive Elementary will be replacing this position.

April 20th is closing for Principal position. We should know by May 1st or 2nd who the new principal will be for Indian Hills.
