Community Service

2428 COMMUNITY SERVICE

The Board of Education requires as part of the requirements for high school graduation that all pupils participate in a Community Service Learning Program. The purpose of the program is to familiarize all pupils with the needs of the community as part of the social studies curriculum. Twenty clock hours of service time shall be required of all pupils. Service time may be completed in one or more community agencies and/or organizations.

Pupils may develop their own independent community service experiences based on the guidelines in Regulation No. 2428 Community Service. All such experiences must be approved by the pupil's parent or legal guardian as well as the supervising teacher and the Community Service Learning Coordinator and the community agency or organization. Pupils and their parents or legal guardians shall be responsible for all transportation to and from the community agency or organization. Pupils may not receive remuneration for the performance of community service.
