Dear Rutland City Public School families,

RCPS is committed to continuing to offer our students meals if school is closed for students due to a teacher strike. If school is open for students, meals will be served at schools per the usual routine. If schools are closed for students, meals will be available for pick up from **8-9 AM** on normal school days at the following locations. Meals can only be picked up for current Rutland City Public School students. Each meal will include one breakfast and one lunch.

Meals will be available for pickup **from the school bus parked** on a first-come, first-served basis, at the sites and times as follows:
