2440 SUMMER SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

Summer School

The Bayonne Board of Education does not conduct a summer school. Summer school for reinforcement and enrichment for elementary school students is always encouraged by the district. However, successful completion of summer school courses taken in another district and/or other schools does not affect grade placement and/or promotion or grades.

On the secondary level, students can take up to two courses in summer school. Effective with the Class of 2005, freshmen, sophomores, and juniors must have a minimum grade of 60 in the failing subject to have permission to attend summer school. Permission to attend summer school must be received from the student's vice principal.

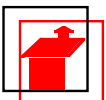
Upon submitting proof of a pass grade, credit will be awarded for those courses. Seniors who fail a course(s) and do have sufficient credits for graduation will be afforded the opportunity to take and pass such courses in an approved summer school. Seniors who do not have sufficient credits for graduation may not participate in the graduation ceremony. A diploma from Bayonne High School will be awarded after the required course(s) have been successfully passed by the student.
