 - ☐ 1 Large block **eraser**
 - ☐ 1 Hand-held manual pencil **sharpener**

- ☐ 2 Packs of **Index cards** (4x6, lined, 100 per pack)
- ☐ 3 **Composition** marble notebooks (Reading/English/Social Studies). Note: Not a spiral.

- ☐ 1 Pair of wired **headphones** that connect to laptop (no wireless or AirPods please)
- ☐ 3 Large boxes of **tissues** (give to homeroom teacher on first day)
- ☐ 2 Containers of sanitizing **wipes** (give to homeroom teacher on first day)
- ☐ 1 Roll of **paper towels** (give to homeroom teacher on first day)
