<u>PLANNERS:</u> Students are REQUIRED to bring their planner to school <u>every day</u> and have their planner on their desk and open to the correct day in homeroom each morning. Pages should never be folded in any way or torn out and there should not be excessive graffiti in your planner. This is both an organizational tool for you and a form of school to home communication. If your planner becomes lost, check all of your classes and the shelves in the office first. Replacement planners are \$5 at the front office.

<u>BIKES</u>: If you ride a bike to school you MUST wear a helmet and have a bike lock. You may not ride your bike on the sidewalk in front of the school; you must dismount and push your bike on the sidewalk. All bikes must be locked on the bike rack while they are on campus.

<u>HYDRO FLASKS, WATER BOTTLES & MORNING DRINKS:</u> Sorry, but for sanitary reasons, only water is allowed in classrooms in your hydro flasks & water bottles. If you bring Starbucks or other drinks in the morning, please finish it BEFORE you walk into homeroom.

<u>CELL PHONES:</u> Remember all cell phones should be OFF and put away BEFORE you step through the gates in the morning until you LEAVE the gates after school.
