

Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights (ABR) Act School Self-Assessment 2023-2024

Interpretation of Grade: The school grade is a raw score of data and the sum of the ratings for all indicators within each core element for the 2023-2024 school year. The maximum grade a school can achieve is 78 points. To achieve this rating, a school would need to demonstrate that they “exceed expectations” on all core elements. The ABS and School Climate Team in each building is responsible for completing the Self-Assessment on an annual basis which determines the school grade.
