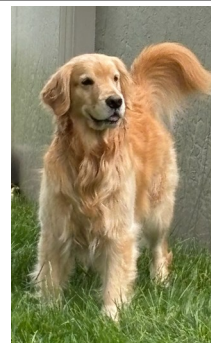

Kids can enjoy music, movement, stories, puppets, and sensory activities to make learning Spanish fun. Geared to ages 1 to 5.

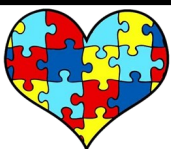

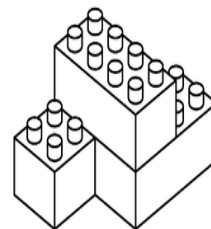
